## LA BELLE ROSE ROSÉ

The La Belle Rose Rosé sparkling wine is a cuvée made from the Pinot Noir, Syrah and Pinot Meunier grape varieties, which was released at the end of August and beginning of September were hand read. Through the gentle and reserved pressing the whole grapes reduced the color extraction to a light and delicate rosé. The juice yield was also correspondingly low, because per kilogram of grapes there is only 55% of the first juice flow suitable for sparkling wine production. The first fermentation took place classically in stainless steel tanks, the second after traditional method in the bottle. After 21 months of yeast storage, the cuvée was made from 65% Pinot Noir, 30% Syrah and 5% Pinot Meunier disgorged and with just under 7 grams of shipping dosage (residual sugar). Even as a young sparkling wine, the delicate rosé, which is very reminiscent of the color play of old English rose varieties inspiring and eponymous for the new “La Belle Rose” Rosé Sparkling wine Brut 2021. The lively nose is also reminiscent of pink flowers, grapefruit and mint. The vitality settles, carried through the fine mousseux, in the mouth.
