PINOT NOIR KAISERBERG

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The majestic "Kaiserberg" Pinot Noir from Nussdorf, a northern district of the city of Landau in the Southern Palatinate, comes from a gently south-facing slope. From the magnificent walnut tree right next to the parcel, there is a wonderful view of the edge of the Haardt Mountains and the Palatinate Forest. The soil consists of dark loess with light limestone, which ensures ideal water retention for the vines. To enhance the complexity of the wine, a mixed planting of the French clones 777 and 828 was carried out, making this parcel our most prestigious in Kaiserberg. To guarantee the highest quality, the grapes were hand picked and additionally sorted by hand on a selection table. The must was spontaneously fermented in used French oak fermenters, the most natural and traditional method. After pressing, the wine aged for 12 months in Pièce barrels made of fine-grained French and Palatinate oak. The 2022 Kaiserberg Pinot Noir presents a deep and expressive nose of red and dark berries, fine spice, and subtle earthy notes. On the palate, it showcases an excellent balance between freshness and ripe fruit, characterized by juicy cherries and fine tannins that provide an elegant structure. The finish is long, with mineral hints and a delicate, subtle wood note that indicates great aging potential.
