RIESLING NUSSRIEGEL





The Nussriegel in Ungstein is one of the finest sites in the Mittelhaardt. Its southerly exposure opens it up to intense sunshine. The sandy soils with their deep-set limestone veins drain away water quickly. Planted in 1976, the vineyard lies in the immediate vicinity of our "Weilberg" grand cru site. As can be expected given that advanced age, yields are typically quite low. After harvest, the grapes are gently crushed using a pneumatic press. The young wine remains on the gross lees until fermentation in late May. Long lees contact and related autolysis leads to a highly complex aromatic profile. Fine vegetable notes supplement the fruit-forward bouquet. To this comes the mouthfeel, which further emphasizes the wine's powerful body.
