CABERNET FRANC SCHLOSSBERG

Planted in 2010, our Cabernet Franc vineyard is located at the foot of the Hambach Schlossberg. The site is characterised by warm conditions and skeletal soils, which consistently limit yields and provide a well-suited environment for the variety. Cabernet Franc is the progenitor of the Cabernet family but remains less prominent than its offspring, Cabernet Sauvignon. The variety is thick-skinned and naturally high in tannins. It ripens slightly earlier and produces wines with clear aromatic definition. Yield-reducing measures such as green harvesting, together with favourable climatic conditions, support full ripeness and concentration. Following a short cold maceration, fermentation took place on the skins using native yeasts. Maturation lasted 14 months in Italian terracotta amphorae. Controlled micro-oxidation in the absence of oak influence results in a refined tannin framework while preserving a pure, varietal expression.
